

## Homestead Property Tax Discount for Veterans Age 65 and Older With a Combat Related Disability

### Who is Eligible?

This amendment provides a property tax discount on homestead property owned by eligible veterans.

### An eligible veteran must:

- Have an honorable discharge from military service;
- be at least 65 years old;
- be partially disabled with a permanent service connected disability, all or a portion of which must be combat-related;
- and, be a Florida resident at the time of entering military service.

### You will need to provide:

- Preferably the DD214, or enlistment documents, clearly showing the place of enlistment.

Note: In our continuing effort to serve the public, and in this case those who bravely served our country, we will try to assist the veteran in establishing proof of residency at the time of application. If the applying veteran cannot provide a copy of his, or her, DD214 showing the jurisdiction of enlistment we will accept a high school diploma, clipping from their hometown newspaper about their enlistment and departure for military service, senior picture in their high school year book, wedding announcement or engagement announcement... we'll take just about anything **within reason** that indicates the veteran's home at the time of enlistment.
