

Homestead Property Tax Discount for Veterans Age 65 and Older

With a Combat Related Disability

Who is Eligible?

This amendment provides a property tax discount on homestead property owned by eligible veterans.

An eligible veteran must:

- Have an honorable discharge from military service;
- be at least 65 years old;
- be partially disabled with a permanent service connected disability, all or a portion of which must be combat related;

You will need to provide:

- Copy of honorable discharge papers (DD 214)
- Copy of ratings discharge letter from the US Department of Veterans Affairs
- Evidence from the Department of Veterans Affairs or military branch identifying the portion of the disability that is combat related, if not included in the ratings decision letter
- Proof of age 65 as of January 1 of current tax year
